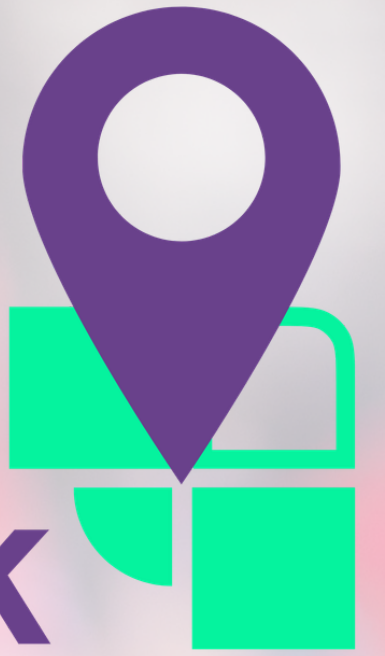

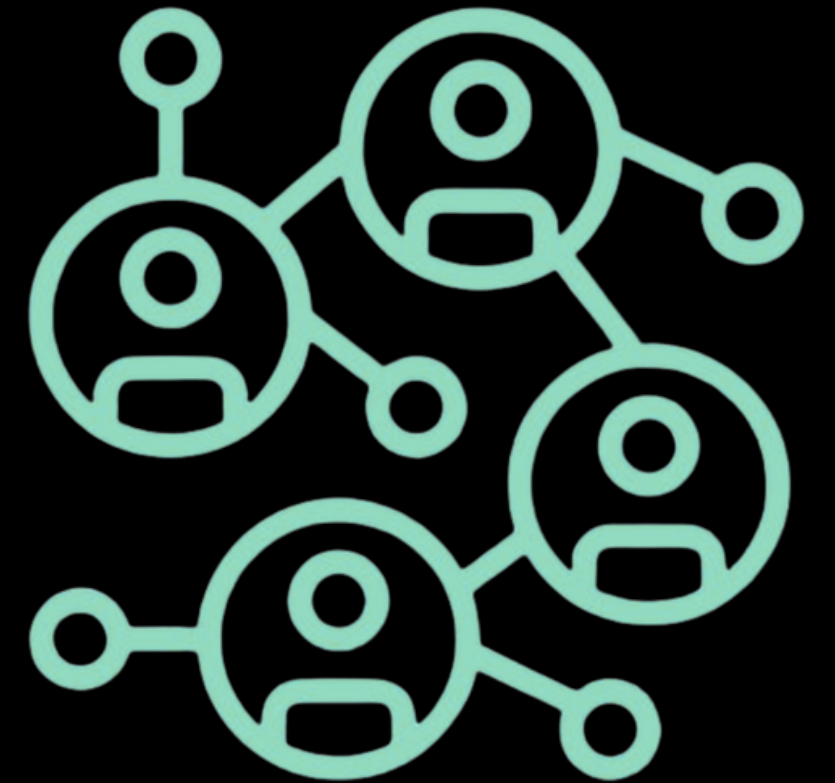
What is JPIT's Constituency Action Network (CAN)?

JPIT's Constituency Action Network is a network of churches across the UK who are committed to building meaningful relationships with their MP and working with them to speak and act for peace and justice.

Social Action...

Many churches are deeply connected to their local community and can speak with experience on the social injustices they face locally.

Their social action work including things like food banks, warm spaces, youth groups and refugee support means they are well placed to cut through to those with the power to make change.



... to Social Justice

By engaging with politics through listening, kindness and truthfulness, churches can build strong relationships with MPs to advocate for their communities.

Finding common ground with an MP through relationship builds power, rather than focusing on the issues you may differ on! Your church community is your MPs constituency so your church's advocacy has influence.



We want to build a network of at least one church in every MPs constituency - The Constituency Action Network, or CAN

When churches sign up to CAN, they commit to:



Getting the whole church community on board, engaging with the Network as part of their mission and outreach



Building a relationship with their MP, to get to know them, help them to engage with your community and open up conversations about key issues.



Speaking up on issues of peace and justice, to advocate for change at a local and national level

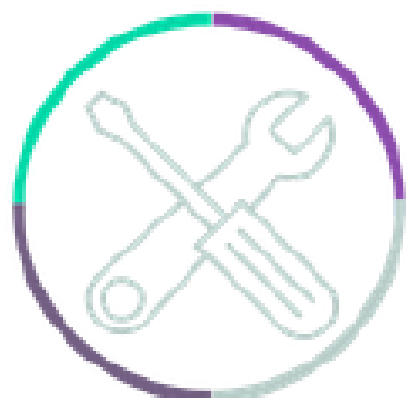
JPIT will support church communities in CAN by:
